

Dear Parishioners.

"Prepare the Way of the Lord" Lk 3:5

This familiar cry of St. John the Baptist defines the Advent Season and should be the mantra we ponder during these weeks of preparation. St. John recalls the words of our first reading from the prophet Baruch. Israel is a defeated people and again in exile because of their unfaithfulness. In the midst of this sadness Baruch reminds the people that hope is not lost. Eventually they will be freed by the hand of God and their own faithfulness and then God will lead them home. They are called to remember that throughout Salvation History God has never abandoned them. The journey back home may seem long and treacherous but God will again send them His power. The roads and pathways to the promised land will be made easy, mountain made low and valleys filled in. The crooked and curved roads will be created as a straight path. What hope that gives the Children of Israel! God is with them.

In his preaching to us in mid-Advent, St. John calls us to repentance, a change to our ways of thinking and acting. What needs to be cleared away to let God enter more deeply into our lives? Baruch and St. John the Baptist announced that God is coming to set things in right order. In our lives and world there are too many valleys of despair that need to be filled; mountains and hills of pride that need to be made low; winding roads of confusion that need straightening and rough, violent ways that must be made smooth. We can't do this on our own. Putting things right is first God's work in Jesus Christ. St. Paul reminds us that God has begun that good work in us. The way has been smoothed so we can now respond in love. We are recipients of the work of salvation that "comes through Jesus Christ for the glory and praise of God."

The world may already be celebrating Christmas but we as Christians must not lose our focus; Christmas is not here. Immerse yourself in Advent and in this time of preparation and anticipation...do it! Prepare, anticipate and turn back to Jesus. He will never leave you and wants that path to your heart free of all stumbling blocks. When it is free He can offer you His hope and consolation. Make your Christmas gift to Jesus a true celebration of Advent.

In this year of faith I continue to encourage you to pray for those who may be away from worship...let the power of the Holy Spirit touch them.
