




# The North Shore Chamber Choir Returns

Conducted by our parish Music Director, **Jeff Schneider**, this beloved oratorio, which includes the world-famous "Hallelujah Chorus,"


will be performed by a 24 voice choir, four soloists (including our own cantor, **Christopher Lau**) and a string quintet.


