



Monsignor Robert Hayden was ordained a priest for the Rockville Center Diocese in 1970. After Ordination he was an Associate at St. Rose of Lima in Massapequa and St. Dominic's in Oyster Bay. After studying at Catholic University, Fr. Bob taught Scripture at the Seminary of the Immaculate Conception in Huntington where he was also the Vice Rector and Academic Dean. He has served as Pastor at the Church of St. Aidan in Williston Park and most recently as Pastor at St. William the Abbot in Seaford. He recently celebrated his 50th Anniversary of his Ordination.
