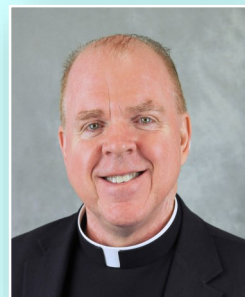

Thoughts from our St. Vincent dePaul Conference

In a recent newsletter from Dave Barringer, the CEO of the St Vincent de Paul National Conference, he challenges us as Vincentians to look at ways that we may be able to allay some of the violence that is constantly in the news, through prayer and service. He discusses how poor health, both physical and mental often lead to unhealthy situations. In our work with families we can see how deficiencies of income, health, medicine and general medical care intersect and often in potentially dangerous ways. If people must make a choice between buying food or medicine, generally food wins. If the medicine is for a mental or psychological condition, this can be a dangerous choice. *So what can we do collectively?*

- Assistance with transportation to a medical or mental health appointment?
- Assistance with copays for physician appointments or medication?
- Assistance with purchasing food?
- Information on medical and/or mental health resources?

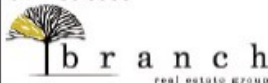

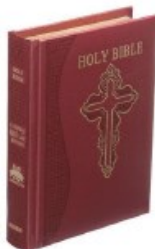
