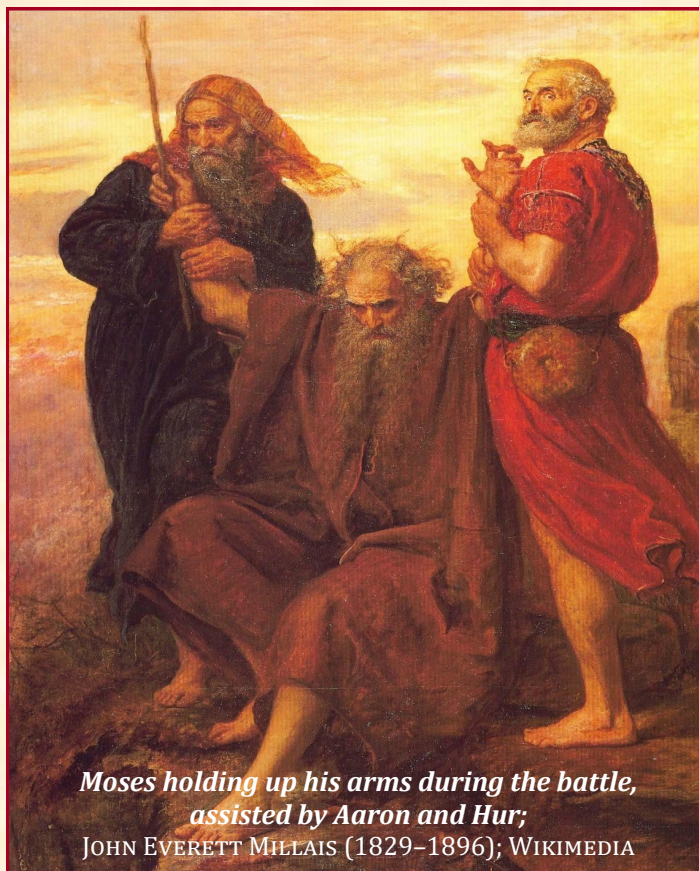

Thermal & military style clothing, boots (dark colors)

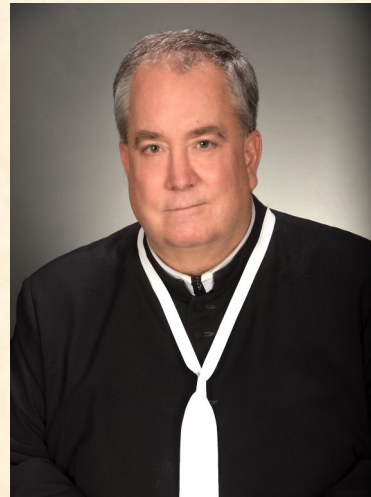

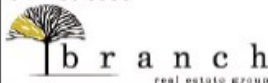

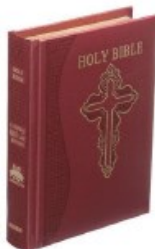
